

Making an arched cable tray

You can create an arched cable tray by carefully planning the curve, selecting flexible or bendable materials, and assembling the tray with supports that follow the arch.

Planning the Arched Tray

Start by measuring the space where the tray will be installed, noting the height, width, and the desired curvature. Sketch a rough layout of the arch to visualize the path and ensure it avoids obstacles like beams or pipes. Determine the number and type of cables to be supported, as this will influence the tray's width and strength requirements .

Choosing Materials

For a durable arched tray, use metal (aluminum or steel) or rigid plastic that can be bent or segmented to follow the curve. For DIY or temporary setups, wood or recycled materials can also be used, shaped into a curved trough . Ensure the material is strong enough to support the cables without sagging.

Creating the Arch

- o Flexible Material Approach: Use bendable metal strips or plastic that can be gently curved along a template or jig to form a smooth arch. Supports or brackets should follow the curve to maintain stability .
- o Custom Fabrication: For precise curves, consider using a sweep or mold technique to shape the tray, especially in software-assisted design or when creating a custom in-place family in CAD tools .

Assembly and Installation

- o Connect side panels and base securely using screws, brackets, or welding, depending on the material .
- o Install end panels and any dividers to separate cable types.
- o Mount the tray along the arch using brackets or supports that follow the curve, ensuring even weight distribution.
- o Route cables carefully, using ties or Velcro straps to prevent tangling and maintain organization.
- o Check stability and make adjustments to ensure the arch holds its shape under load .

Finishing Touches

- o Paint or coat the tray for corrosion resistance or aesthetics.
- o Label cable sections for easier maintenance.

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o Regularly inspect the tray to ensure cables remain secure and the arch maintains its integrity .
