

Manufacturer s process of making distribution boxes

1. Design and Planning

4. Cutting and Creasing

The corrugated board is then cut and creased using slotters and die-cutting machines to create folding lines, flaps, tabs, or windows as required. Accurate creasing ensures smooth folding and proper box formation in later steps .

5. Printing and Branding

Boxes are often printed with logos, instructions, barcodes, or other branding elements using flexographic or digital printing methods. Special coatings or laminates may be applied to enhance durability and visual appeal .

6. Folding and Gluing



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The flat, creased boards are folded into box shapes and glued at designated areas. Glue types vary depending on the application, such as water-based adhesives for food-grade boxes or hot-melt adhesives for heavy-duty boxes. Once dried, the boxes become rigid and ready for use .

7. Quality Assurance

Finally, boxes undergo inspection to ensure proper alignment, complete gluing, and correct dimensions. This step ensures that distribution boxes meet quality standards and are suitable for shipping and storage .
