Enclosure Materials

The outer casing of a distribution box must be strong, impact-resistant, and fire-retardant. Common materials include:

- o Steel (galvanized or stainless): Offers high strength, corrosion resistance, and protection against physical impacts; suitable for industrial or outdoor installations .
- o Aluminum: Lightweight, corrosion-resistant, and easy to install; ideal for damp or outdoor environments .
- o Thermoset plastics (e.g., Sheet Molding Compounds - SMC): Provide excellent insulation, fire resistance, and durability; often used in high-voltage or outdoor applications .
- o Engineering thermoplastics (Polycarbonate, Acrylonitrile Styrene Acrylate - ASA): Lightweight, shatter-resistant, and flame-retardant; suitable for indoor or light-duty applications .
- o PVC or High-Density Polyethylene (HDPE): Lightweight, corrosion-resistant, and suitable for indoor use .

Internal Components

A primary distribution box houses critical electrical components to safely distribute power:

- o Circuit breakers or fuses: Protect circuits from overloads and short circuits .
- o Busbars: Conduct electricity efficiently between incoming and outgoing circuits .
- o Insulating supports and barriers: Ensure electrical isolation and prevent accidental contact .
- o Surge protection devices: Optional, for safeguarding against voltage spikes .
- o Wiring terminals and connectors: Facilitate secure connections for incoming and outgoing circuits .

Material Requirements and Safety Considerations

- o Impact resistance: Materials must withstand accidental knocks or falls without cracking .
- o Fire and heat resistance: Enclosure materials should resist burning and contain sparks; flame retardancy is often rated according to IEC 60695 standards .
- o Electrical insulation: Plastics and thermoset materials provide high insulation to prevent leakage and ensure safety .
- o Environmental suitability: Choose materials based on indoor/outdoor use, exposure to moisture, dust, or corrosive environments; check IP ratings for dust and water protection . By selecting the appropriate
