

Method for installing a concealed door to a distribution box

Article Overview

A concealed distribution box can be safely installed by embedding it in the wall, securing it firmly, and covering it with a custom door or cabinet for aesthetic concealment.

Step 1: Prepare the Wall Opening

- o Reserve a hole in the wall 20mm larger than the distribution box in both length and width, with a depth equal to the box thickness plus plastering thickness ().
- o Ensure the wall area is structurally sound to support the box and door.

Step 2: Fix the Distribution Box

- o Embed the box into the wall and fill gaps with concrete if using masonry for stability ().
- o Ensure the box is level and plumb, with vertical deviation not exceeding 3mm.
- o Apply anti-corrosion paint to contact surfaces between the box and wall to prevent rust ().

Step 3: Electrical Wiring

- o Connect the power line to the intermediate contact terminal and the load line to the threaded terminal to prevent electric shock during fuse replacement ().
- o Install AC, DC, or multi-voltage circuits with clear labeling.
- o Separate neutral (N) and protective earth (PE) busbars, and number all connections for clarity ().
- o Dress wires neatly, secure with cable ties, and leave space for heat dissipation ().

Step 4: Concealing the Box

- o Build a custom cabinet or door that matches the wall or interior design (). Options include:
 - o Small wooden cabinet painted or finished to blend with the wall.
 - o Storage space or closet that doubles as a functional area while hiding the box.
- o Ensure the door or cabinet allows easy access for maintenance and complies with safety regulations ().

Step 5: Final Checks

- o Perform visual inspection and multimeter tests to verify proper wiring and insulation ().
- o Label all circuits clearly for future troubleshooting.
- o Ensure the concealed door opens smoothly without obstructing access to breakers or fuses. By following
