Morocco intends to build a 500MW renewable energy data center. The country's digital transition minister, Amal El Fallah Saghrouchni, told Reuters that the facility would be located in Dakhla, a city run by Moroccan authorities in the disputed territory of Western Sahara. The facility aims to bolster the protection and localisation of sensitive data. Electricity can be generated in two main ways: by harnessing the heat from burning fuels or nuclear reactions in the form of steam (thermal power) or by capturing the energy of natural forces such as the sun, wind or moving water.
