- o Avoid daisy-chaining: Connecting multiple power strips together or using long extension cords can overload circuits, generate heat, and increase fire risk, which violates OSHA and NEC regulations .
- o Temporary use only: Power strips and extension cords should not be used as permanent wiring; OSHA limits temporary wiring to 90 days .
- o Cord management: Keep cords straight and avoid excessive lengths to reduce trip hazards and prevent damage .
- o Circuit protection: Many industrial strips include built-in circuit breakers or fuses to prevent overcurrent and protect connected equipment .
