A pass-through patch panel is essentially RJ45-to-RJ45 at the panel. Instead of terminating horizontal cable into an IDC (punch-down) or into keystone modules, you're often dealing with a panel that behaves like a bulkhead: you patch on the front, and there is a corresponding port. Based on different termination methods, FS Ethernet patch panels are primarily classified into three patch panel types: punch down, feed-through, and blank keystone.
