The number of landscape electrical distribution boxes depends on the total electrical load, circuit requirements, and site layout rather than a fixed standard.

Determining Factors

- o **Electrical Load and Circuit Distribution** Each distribution box serves as a junction point to split incoming power into multiple branch circuits. For landscape projects, circuits may include lighting, water features, pumps, and outdoor outlets. The total load and number of circuits determine how many boxes are needed to safely distribute power without overloading any single unit .
- o **Site Layout and Distance** Large gardens, parks, or commercial landscapes may require multiple boxes to minimize voltage drop and ensure circuits are within safe cable length limits. Boxes are typically placed near clusters of electrical devices to reduce long cable runs and improve maintenance access .
- o **Environmental Considerations** Outdoor boxes must meet NEC Article 312 requirements for wet locations, including rain-tight enclosures (NEMA 3R or 4) and corrosion-resistant materials for coastal or humid environments. The number of boxes may increase if the site has multiple exposure zones or requires redundancy for safety .
- o **Code Compliance and Safety** Each box should include proper grounding, overcurrent protection, and main disconnects if the system exceeds 100A. Compliance with local electrical codes and standards (NEC, UL 50/50E, or BS7671 in the UK) may influence the number and placement of boxes .

Practical Guidelines

- o **Small residential landscapes:** Often 1-2 boxes suffice, typically near the main service or at key lighting clusters.
- o **Medium commercial landscapes:** 2-5 boxes may be required, depending on the number of circuits and distance between features.
- o **Large parks or industrial sites:** Multiple boxes (5+) are common, strategically placed to serve different zones and reduce cable runs.
