A wall-mounted distribution box is an electrical structure that is attached directly to a vertical surface. It usually holds control devices, 600V DC circuit breakers, and contactors. These small units are sealed on six sides and have pre-designed knockout points for cables to enter. Wooden plugs driven into holes in masonry, concrete, plaster, or similar materials shall not be used.
