Indoor Distribution Optical Fiber Cables These cables typically consist of multiple tight-buffered fibers as the basic unit, with high-modulus aramid yarn as the strength member and a jacket made of PVC or LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen). They usually contain 2 to 24 fiber cores and are used for indoor integrated wiring, main building wiring, and multi-fiber patchcord connections . **Branched Distribution Optical Cables** Designed for larger networks with more than 24 cores, these cables include a fiber-reinforced composite plastic (GFRP/KFRP) central strength member, with sub-cables stranded around it and a protective jacket of PVC or LSZH. They are ideal for complex indoor or campus network deployments . **Outdoor and Outside Plant (OSP) Fiber Cables** These cables are engineered for aerial, duct, or underground installations. They often feature water-blocking materials, UV-resistant jackets, and reinforced strength members to withstand environmental stress. OSP cables support FTTx deployments and provide high-density connectivity for service providers .
