

Price of galvanized explosion-proof junction boxes and elbows

Junction Boxes

Explosion-proof junction boxes are designed to safely contain sparks or flames in hazardous areas and are commonly made from aluminum, stainless steel, or heavy-duty cast metals with galvanized finishes for corrosion resistance . Prices vary based on:

- o Size and volume: Small 2-4 inch boxes may start around \$50-\$100, while larger multi-terminal boxes can exceed \$400-\$500 .
- o Material: Aluminum and galvanized steel are generally less expensive than stainless steel.
- o Certification: ATEX, IECEx, UL, and CSA approvals for Zones 1, 2, 21, and 22 can increase cost.
- o Configuration: Number of terminals, hubs, and cable entries affects pricing . For example, malleable iron GR type conduit outlet boxes with multiple hubs and internal grounding can range from \$80 to \$300 depending on size and hub count .

Elbows and Conduit Fittings

Explosion-proof elbows and conduit fittings are used to route wiring safely in hazardous areas. Prices depend on:

- o Material: Galvanized steel or aluminum is common; stainless steel is more expensive.
- o Size and angle: 90° or 45° elbows for 3/4 " to 2" conduit typically cost \$20-\$150 per piece.
- o Certification: Must meet the same explosion-proof standards as junction boxes for hazardous zones .

Factors Affecting Cost

- o Zone classification: Higher-risk zones (Zone 1 or Zone 21) require stricter standards, increasing price.
- o Ingress protection (IP rating): IP66 or higher for dust and water resistance adds to cost.
- o Customization: Custom terminal layouts, additional hubs, or special coatings can significantly increase price .
