Distribution Boxes (Junction Boxes)

- o **Material:** Plastic boxes are generally lower cost than metal enclosures.
- o **Certification:** Compliance with IRAM/IEC standards is mandatory, which can increase cost.
- o **Import vs Domestic:** Imported boxes from Brazil, China, or the U.S. may carry higher landed costs due to shipping and customs .

- o **Conduit type:** PVC, galvanized steel (EMT, IMC, RSC), or flexible non-metallic conduits, with steel conduits generally more expensive .
- o **Installation complexity:** Longer runs, multiple floors, or industrial-grade installations increase labor and material costs.
- o **Certification:** All materials must meet IRAM/IEC standards, ensuring safety and compliance .
- o **Labor:** Installation costs are influenced by local labor rates and project scale, with larger infrastructure projects often benefiting from economies of scale .

- o Inflation and currency volatility in Argentina significantly affect the cost of imported electrical components .
- o Urban and industrial hubs such as Buenos Aires, Cordoba, and Santa Fe have higher demand and slightly

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higher prices due to logistics and project density .

o Supply sources: Local manufacturers provide standard boxes and conduits, while U.S. suppliers are often used for hard-to-find or specialized components, with delivery coordinated via DDP or buyer-handled customs .

While exact prices fluctuate, general guidance includes:

- o Standard plastic junction boxes: Moderate cost, often used in residential and commercial projects.
- o Metal enclosures with IP65/IP67 rating: Higher cost, suitable for industrial or outdoor construction sites.
- o Complete wiring installation per "boca completa": Cost varies by project size, conduit type, and labor, typically quoted by installers on a per-unit basis .
