Distribution Box

A distribution box, also called a distribution board or panel, is the central hub of an electrical system that receives power from the main supply and distributes it to multiple branch circuits . Its main functions include:

- o Power distribution: Divides incoming electricity into smaller circuits for different areas or devices.
- o Protection: Houses circuit breakers, fuses, and residual current devices (RCDs) to prevent overloads, short circuits, and earth faults .
- o Organization: Keeps wiring orderly and accessible for maintenance.
- o Monitoring and control: Advanced smart DB boxes can include energy monitoring units and communication modules for real-time data and remote control . Components typically include busbars, circuit breakers or fuses, terminals, switches, and indicator lights. Distribution boxes can be made from metal (steel or aluminum) for industrial durability or plastic (PVC, polycarbonate) for residential use . They can be installed indoors or outdoors, depending on environmental exposure.

Protection Box

A protection box is designed primarily to safeguard electrical circuits and equipment from hazards such as overcurrent, short circuits, or voltage spikes. While it may resemble a distribution box, its focus is on circuit protection rather than power distribution. Protection boxes often contain:

- o Circuit breakers or fuses to interrupt faulty currents.
- o Surge protection devices to prevent damage from voltage spikes.
- o Insulated enclosures to prevent accidental contact and ensure safety. Protection boxes are commonly used in both residential and industrial settings to enhance safety and prevent equipment damage.
