Protective Role

It shields the fibers from physical stress, including crushing, bending, abrasion, and impact during installation or handling, preventing microbends or fractures that could degrade signal transmission . The sheath also bundles and contains the internal components, maintaining the cable's geometry and ensuring consistent optical performance .

Environmental and Chemical Resistance

Sheaths protect fibers from moisture, UV radiation, temperature extremes, and chemical exposure. For outdoor or underground applications, materials like HDPE provide long-term resistance to weathering, while LSZH sheaths are designed for fire safety in indoor environments . The sheath may also include water-blocking gels or aramid yarns to prevent moisture ingress and enhance tensile strength .

Material Considerations

Common sheath materials include PVC, PE, LSZH, PVDF, and rodent-resistant compounds. Each material is chosen based on the deployment environment:

- o PVC: Good chemical resistance, low cost, flame retardant, suitable for general indoor use .
- o PE (Polyethylene): Excellent UV resistance, low water absorption, and high flexibility, ideal for outdoor applications .
- o LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen): Fire-safe, produces minimal smoke, often required by building codes .

Additional Functions

Beyond protection, the sheath contributes to structural integrity, ensuring the cable remains manageable and durable over its service life. Some sheaths also include flame-retardant or UV-resistant coatings to meet safety standards and extend the lifespan of the cable .
