- o Power Issues: Inconsistent power supply to the router or ONT can disrupt signal detection .

Troubleshooting Steps

- o Check for ISP Outages: Visit your ISP's website or social media for service updates.
- o Inspect the Fiber Cable: Ensure the cable is intact, properly connected, and free from sharp bends or damage. Clean connectors if necessary.
- o Restart the Router/ONT: Power off the device, unplug it for 30 seconds, then reconnect and turn it back on .
- o Verify Connections: Make sure all cables, including power and Ethernet, are securely connected.
- o Contact Your ISP: If the red light persists after these steps, the issue may be outside your home, requiring professional support .
