- o **Prepare Mounting Points:** Ensure threaded rods, ceiling anchors, or wall flanges are secure and capable of supporting the new hangers. Replace any damaged fixings.
- o **Install Hangers:** Attach hangers to the mounting points, ensuring they are level and spaced according to the tray manufacturer's recommendations. Use M10 threaded rods for G Hangers where applicable .
- o **Reposition Cable Trays:** Lift the trays onto the new hangers, securing them with hold-down brackets if required. Check alignment and stability.
- o **Inspect and Test:** Verify that all trays are level, properly supported, and free from excessive movement. Ensure compliance with safety standards.

- o **Material:** Use pre-galvanized, hot-dipped galvanized, or stainless steel hangers for long-term durability and corrosion resistance .
