Safety First

Before any work begins, turn off the main power supply at the service panel to eliminate the risk of electric shock. Verify that the circuit is de-energized using a non-contact voltage tester. This step is critical because distribution boxes handle high-voltage electricity and improper handling can cause serious injury or death .

Legal and Code Considerations

In most regions, including Germany and the U.S., removal or relocation of a distribution box is subject to strict electrical codes. Work must comply with standards such as DIN VDE 0100 in Germany or the National Electrical Code (NEC) in the U.S. This includes ensuring proper grounding, circuit labeling, and accessibility of junction boxes . - o Prepare for New Installation or Relocation: If relocating, ensure the new location meets code, has sufficient space, and allows proper cable routing .
