

# Router connecting two fiber optic cables

- o **Set the default route** on the second router to point to the first router's IP on the fiber link. This allows traffic to flow through the primary router to the internet or other networks .

- o **Testing and Verification:** After connecting the fiber and configuring IP addresses, verify connectivity using ping tests or router diagnostics to ensure the optical link is active and stable .

- o **Distance and Signal Loss:** Check the SFP module's maximum distance rating and ensure the fiber length does not exceed it.

- o **Duplex vs. Simplex:** Use duplex fiber for full-duplex communication; simplex may be used for one-way links if required .

- o **Professional Installation:** If running fiber through walls or conduits, consider a trained technician to avoid damage and signal degradation .
