Environmental and Placement Factors

Fiber itself is resilient, but router placement affects Wi-Fi stability. Avoid placing the router near microwave ovens, Bluetooth devices, or metal objects, and ensure it is centrally located and elevated for optimal coverage. Dense walls or floors can weaken Wi-Fi signals, causing apparent disconnections even if the fiber link is stable .

Network Configuration and ISP Issues

Check for IP conflicts, incorrect routing, or overloaded network traffic. If wired devices remain stable while wireless devices drop, the issue is likely Wi-Fi-specific. Persistent disconnections affecting all devices may indicate a problem with your ISP or fiber modem, in which case contact your provider for diagnostics .

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- o Reduce Wi-Fi channel width (e.g., 2.4GHz to 20MHz) to minimize interference.
- o Disable Smart Connect features if your router supports them, as they can cause instability with certain devices.
- o Monitor signal strength and note patterns of disconnection to identify environmental or device-specific causes . By systematically checking cables, hardware, firmware, placement, and configuration, most fiber optic router disconnection issues can be resolved without replacing the entire system.
