

Router upgrade to fiber optic interface

Steps to Upgrade Your Router for Fiber Internet

1. Confirm Fiber Availability and Installation Before upgrading, ensure fiber optic service is available in your area by checking with your ISP or using online availability tools. If fiber isn't yet installed, a technician may need to extend the network to your home . 2. Install the Optical Network Terminal (ONT) Fiber internet uses an ONT instead of a traditional modem. The ONT converts light signals from the fiber cable into an Ethernet connection for your router. ISPs typically provide and install the ONT, which is usually placed in a convenient location like a closet or corner of a room . 3. Choose a Compatible Router Your router must support high-speed Ethernet input to handle fiber speeds. Look for:

- o Gigabit Ethernet WAN port to connect to the ONT
 - o Wi-Fi 6 or Wi-Fi 7 support for optimal wireless performance
 - o Strong processing power for multiple devices and high bandwidth usage
4. Connect Your Router to the ONT Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT to your router's WAN port. Ensure the ONT is powered on and active. Some ISPs may require authentication or specific VLAN/PPPoE settings, which can be configured in the router's admin panel . 5. Configure and Optimize Your Network
- o Update firmware on both the router and ONT for security and performance improvements
 - o Secure your Wi-Fi network with a strong password and encryption
 - o Use wired connections for critical devices to reduce latency
 - o Test internet speeds to confirm you are achieving the expected fiber performance
6. Optional: Upgrade for Full Fiber Speeds If your current router is outdated, upgrading to a modern Wi-Fi 6 or Wi-Fi 7 router can unlock the full potential of fiber internet, providing faster upload/download speeds, better coverage, and improved handling of multiple devices .
