SC pigtail fiber is a pre-terminated optical fiber with an SC connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other, available in single-mode or multimode types with various buffer and jacket options.

Overview

An SC pigtail fiber is a short optical fiber cable designed for splicing into a fiber optic network. One end has a factory-terminated SC connector, while the other end is bare for fusion or mechanical splicing to a trunk or distribution cable. The SC connector uses a push-pull mechanism and comes in two main variants:

- o SC/APC (Angled Physical Contact): Features an 8° angled ferrule to minimize back reflection (< -60 dB), ideal for FTTH, telecom, and long-distance single-mode applications.
- o SC/UPC (Ultra Physical Contact): Provides a flat polish with lower back reflection than standard connectors, commonly used in data centers.

Fiber Types

SC pigtails are available in both single-mode and multimode fibers:

- o Single-mode: G652D, G657A2 (bend-insensitive), OS2 for long-distance and FTTH applications.
- o Multimode: OM2, OM3, OM4, OM5 for in-building, data center, and short-distance applications.

Buffer and Jacket Options

The fiber can come in different buffer diameters and jackets to match installation requirements:

- o Bare fiber: 250 µm for direct splicing.
- o Tight-buffered fiber: 900 µm, suitable for splice trays and closures.
- o Jacketed minicables: 2.0 mm or 3.0 mm, simplex or duplex (zip-cord) constructions for easier handling and protection.
- o Jacket materials: PVC, LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen), armored, or outdoor-rated for environmental protection.
