 - o SFP+ (10G): For 10GbE switches, with multimode or single-mode options
 - o SFP28 (25G): High-performance intra-data-center links, e.g., FS.com 25G SFP28 SR (100m OM4) or LR (10km SMF) modules
- o Reach and Wavelength: Match fiber type (OM1-OM4 for multimode, OS1/OS2 for single-mode) and distance requirements.
- o Digital Optical Monitoring (DOM): Provides real-time diagnostics for proactive network management .
