

Article Overview

Overhauling distribution boxes requires attention to material quality, IP protection, busbar configuration, cable entry, and compliance with electrical standards.

Material and Construction

Distribution boxes should be fabricated from high-quality materials such as ABS or PC plastics for waterproof boxes, or 2 mm galvanized steel for outdoor LT distribution boxes, ensuring mechanical strength and corrosion resistance . The body should have reinforcements and suitable channels for mounting components, and doors should have robust hinges and secure locking systems, such as Godrej-type 3-position locks .

Protection and Safety

- o Ingress Protection (IP): For outdoor or industrial applications, boxes should meet IP55 to IP65 standards, providing dustproof and waterproof protection .
- o Earthing: Include solid earthing points on either side of the box for safety .
- o Arc Protection: For high-capacity boxes, isolators should have arc chutes to extinguish arcs immediately, and porcelain cutouts may be used for outgoing circuits .

Busbars and Electrical Components

- o Busbar Material: Use copper or EC-grade aluminum with proper cross-section dimensions depending on KVA rating (e.g., 72x50x8 mm for 63/100 KVA, 112x50x15 mm for 160/315 KVA), .
- o Insulation: Busbars should have PVC insulating sleeves with standard color coding for phases, or heat-shrinkable tubing for phase identification .
- o Incoming and Outgoing Droppers: Ensure adequate cross-section and proper drilling for secure connections .

Cable Entry and Wiring

- o Cable Glands: Provide heavy-duty, double-compression brass cable glands for incoming and outgoing cables .
- o Wiring Space: Ensure ample space for wiring and modular components, with clear separation between phases and neutral/earth connections .
- o Phase Sequence: Maintain correct RYB phase sequence throughout the box .

- o Roof Design: Slightly sloping roofs with overhangs prevent water accumulation .
- o Transparent Doors: For smaller residential or commercial boxes, transparent doors allow visual inspection of modular devices without opening the box .
- o Compliance: All components should comply with IEC60529, IS standards, and local electrical regulations .
