 - o Mounting: Ensure the brick-built box is flush with the wall and allows for door clearance and ventilation. Reinforced mounting points are recommended for heavy industrial panels .
 - o Fire and Weather Ratings: For outdoor or workshop use, select boxes with IP66 or fire-rated construction to protect internal components .
