



Standard requirements for the obstruction height of distribution boxes

Preview

Wall-mounted boxes should be 4. This height makes it easy to reach without bending or stretching. Ground-mounted boxes should be raised 2 to 4 inches to avoid. The proper installation of a distribution box involves placing it at the right height to ensure safety and convenience. This height also safeguards the box from potential. One distribution board or consumer unit is enough for one residential premises including the meter. Check for proper IP/NEMA ratings and material quality. Ensure safe placement: install in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation and at appropriate height (typically ~1.
