OSFP (Octal Small Form Factor Pluggable) transceivers enable high-speed 400G and 800G optical networking, offering scalable, thermally optimized solutions for Swiss retail and enterprise PON deployments.

Overview of OSFP Technology

OSFP is an open standard pluggable optical transceiver designed to support ultra-high-speed connectivity with eight electrical lanes per module, each capable of 100G PAM4, allowing total bandwidths of 400G or 800G depending on configuration (). Unlike QSFP-DD, OSFP emphasizes thermal management and electrical performance, making it suitable for power-intensive applications such as AI clusters, data centers, and high-bandwidth enterprise networks (). Key features include:

- o High-density connectivity for large-scale networks
- o Enhanced thermal management to handle up to 15-20W power dissipation
- o Interoperability across vendors via the OSFP Multi-Source Agreement (MSA) ()
- o Breakout capability to 8x100G or 2x400G for flexible network scaling ()

OSFP in Passive Optical Networks (PON)

In Swiss retail and enterprise PON deployments, OSFP modules can be integrated into central office or metro aggregation nodes, providing high-speed optical links to support:

- o Data center interconnects (DCI)
- o Short-reach metro access
- o High-bandwidth enterprise connectivity Smartoptics OSFP variants, such as DR4, FR4, and LR4, support distances from 500 meters up to 10 km over single-mode fiber, making them suitable for both intra-data center and metro PON applications ().
