- o Visual inspection: Look for physical damage, bends, or corrosion on connectors and cable ends .
- o Optical Power Meter (OPM): Measures light signal strength to identify low power or high attenuation areas .
- o OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer): Sends laser pulses through the fiber and measures reflections to pinpoint the fault location. This method is precise and suitable for all types of optical fiber cables .

Repair Procedures

Once a fault is located, repair depends on the type and location:

- o Using existing cable reserves: If spare fiber length is available, it can be pulled to replace the damaged section .
- o Connector replacement: If the fault is near a connector, replacing or reseating the connector may restore service .
- o Splicing: For breaks without nearby reserves, fibers are spliced to continue the line, ensuring minimal signal loss .
