Fiber optic cable inspection in Tanzania follows national standards and involves specialized testing, maintenance, and deployment services provided by certified companies.

Standards and Guidelines

Fiber optic networks in Tanzania are governed by the Tanzania Bureau of Standards (TBS), which provides detailed requirements for deployment, maintenance, and inspection of fiber optic cables. The standards cover core, backbone, and access/last mile networks, specifying installation methods (underground, aerial, submarine), cable specifications, attenuation limits, chromatic dispersion, and environmental tolerances (-50°C to 70°C) to ensure optimal performance and reliability. Jointing chambers such as handholes and manholes have defined dimensions and spacing to facilitate inspection and maintenance .

Inspection and Testing Procedures

Inspection of fiber optic cables typically includes:

- o Duct Integrity Testing (DIT) to ensure conduits are free of obstructions .
- o Cable Splicing and Termination Checks to verify proper connections and signal continuity .
- o Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer (OTDR) Testing to measure attenuation, detect faults, and confirm cable performance.
- o Environmental Monitoring in stations or containers to track temperature, humidity, and airflow, ensuring cable longevity .

- o Follow TBS guidelines for spacing of handholes (2 km for direct buried, 500 m for ducted) and manholes (4 km) to maintain accessibility for inspection and repairs .
- o Regularly perform OTDR and duct integrity tests to detect faults early and maintain network reliability. By adhering to these standards and engaging certified service providers, Tanzania ensures that its fiber optic networks remain efficient, reliable, and future-ready.
