Ventilation, fans, or cooling systems are often integrated to maintain optimal operating temperatures and protect equipment from overheating . 7. Optional Accessories Additional components may include shelves for non-rack-mountable devices, grounding kits, and monitoring sensors for temperature, humidity, or airflow.
