- o Repositioning: Move the box to a safe, accessible, and ventilated location if necessary .
- o Upgrade protection: Install or verify circuit breakers, fuses, and surge protection for each branch circuit .
- o Organize wiring: Use cable ties, channels, or modular designs to keep wires neat and prevent accidental contact .
- o Regular maintenance: Schedule periodic inspections to detect wear, moisture ingress, or loose connections early .

- o Always select a distribution box suitable for the environment (indoor/outdoor) and load capacity .
- o Follow manufacturer instructions and local electrical codes during installation .
- o Avoid DIY installation unless you have professional electrical knowledge, as improper setup can lead to fire, electric shock, or equipment failure .
- o Label circuits clearly and maintain documentation for future upgrades or troubleshooting . By addressing these issues promptly and following proper installation standards, you can ensure your distribution box operates safely and reliably, minimizing the risk of electrical hazards and service interruptions.
