It happens during installation, when excessive pulling force, tight bends. Proper fiber optic cable installation is critical to ensuring network performance and long-term reliability. This article outlines three key errors and how to avoid them. Start with the simplest, fastest checks (visual inspection, cleaning, cable routing) and only move to instrumentation (power meter, VFL, OTDR) when those steps don't clear the fault.

2 -- Bend radius violations (macrobends and microbends) Symptom: wavelength-dependent loss (often worse at longer wavelengths), loss that spikes when a cable is flexed or moved, or visible tight loops
