

# The live wire in the distribution box must be connected to the circuit

## Article Overview

The live wire from the main supply must be connected to the input terminal of the main MCB or main switch in the distribution box, which then distributes power to individual circuit breakers.

### Step-by-Step Connection

- o Turn Off Main Power Before starting, ensure the main supply is switched off and verify with a voltage tester to prevent electric shock .
- o Identify Components A typical distribution box includes a main switch or MCB, branch circuit breakers, a neutral bus bar, and an earth bus bar .
- o Connect the Live Wire
  - o The incoming live (phase) wire from the main supply should be connected to the input terminal of the main MCB or main switch .

- o Distribute Power to Circuits
  - o The output of the main MCB is connected to the input of the RCCB (if installed) for additional protection .
  - o From the RCCB output, connect the live wire to the input terminals of branch MCBs for individual circuits .
- o Neutral and Earth Connections
  - o Connect the neutral wire from the supply to the neutral bus bar, which distributes it to all circuits .
  - o Connect the earth wire to the earth bus bar to ensure proper grounding and safety .
- o Final Checks
  - o Ensure all connections are tight, properly insulated, and no wires are loose or exposed .
  - o Arrange wires neatly to avoid overcrowding inside the distribution box .
  - o After verifying connections, restore power and test each circuit for proper operation .

### Safety Considerations

- o Always use wires of appropriate gauge for the load to prevent overheating .
- o Follow local electrical codes and standards for installation.
- o If unsure, consult a licensed electrician to avoid hazards . By following this sequence, the live wire is safely connected to the distribution box, ensuring proper power distribution and protection for all circuits.
