- o Measure voltage levels and check for balanced three-phase voltage within $\pm 5\%$.
- o Test grounding continuity and resistance .
- o Perform insulation resistance testing on conductors .
- o Test RCDs and circuit breakers under load conditions to ensure proper operation .
- o Use thermal imaging to detect hot spots and check connector temperatures (
