The most commonly used fiber optic connector types in Monaco include LC, SC, FC, ST, MPO/MTP, MT-RJ, MU, DIN, E2000, SMA, BICONIC, and CS, covering both single-mode and multimode applications.

Common Fiber Optic Connector Types

1. LC (Lucent Connector)

- o Small form factor with a 1.25mm ceramic ferrule, ideal for high-density applications.
- o Push-pull latch design for easy insertion and removal.
- o Supports both single-mode and multimode fibers, commonly used in data centers and telecom networks .

2. SC (Subscriber Connector)

- o Rectangular body with a 2.5mm ferrule and push-pull mechanism.
- o Durable and cost-effective, widely used in FTTH deployments and backbone networks.
- o Available in UPC (flat polish) and APC (angled polish) variants for low return loss .

3. FC (Ferrule Connector)

- o 2.5mm ferrule with a screw-on locking mechanism for mechanical stability.
- o Suitable for high-vibration environments and long-term connections .

4. ST (Straight Tip)

- o Bayonet-style connector with a 2.5mm ferrule.
- o Common in legacy networks and multimode applications .

5. MPO/MTP (Multi-Fiber Push-On / Multi-Fiber Termination Push-On)

- o High-density connectors supporting multiple fibers in a single ferrule.
- o Ideal for data centers and high-speed backbone networks .

6. MT-RJ (Mechanical Transfer Registered Jack)

- o Compact duplex connector with 1.25mm ferrules.
- o Used in high-density multimode applications .

7. MU (Miniature Unit)

- o Small form factor similar to LC, often used in telecom and high-density patch panels .

8. DIN (Deutsches Institut für Normung)

- o Screw-type connector with high precision, used in industrial and European networks .

9. E2000

- o Push-pull connector with protective shutter, providing high return loss and low insertion loss.
- o Common in single-mode telecom networks .

10. SMA (SubMiniature version A)

- o Threaded connector, historically used in test equipment and specialty applications .

11. BICONIC

- o Older connector type with a conical ferrule, largely replaced by modern connectors but still found in legacy systems .

12. CS (Compact Small)

- o Small form factor connector for high-density applications, similar to LC .
