Preparation and Site Survey

- o Electrical Connection: Plug the UPS into a dedicated power outlet that matches the required voltage. Avoid overloading the UPS by checking the total power draw of connected devices .
- o Device Connection: Connect critical devices (servers, routers, workstations) to battery-backed outlets. Non-critical devices can be connected to surge-protected outlets if available .

Testing and Commissioning

After installation, allow the UPS to fully charge (typically 8-12 hours). Perform functional tests, including a load bank test if applicable, to verify that the UPS can handle the connected load and switch to battery mode seamlessly during a power outage . Document all installation steps, test results, and provide handover instructions to the responsible personnel.

Regularly inspect the UPS for dust, ventilation blockages, and battery health. Follow the manufacturer's
