Step-by-Step Guide

1. **Safety First** Before starting, disconnect all power sources and verify zero voltage using a multimeter. Wear insulated gloves and safety glasses to prevent accidental shocks or short circuits . 2. **Select the Busbar and Wire** Choose a busbar rated for the total current of your USB devices. For standard USB 5V lines, the current is usually low (0.5-3A per port), but ensure the busbar can handle the combined load. Use appropriately sized wires (typically 20-16 AWG for USB) and high-quality terminal lugs . 3. **Prepare the Wires** Strip the insulation from the wire ends carefully without nicking the copper strands. Slide the correct terminal lug onto the stripped wire, ensuring full contact with the conductor . 4. **Connect to the Busbar**

- o Attach the positive USB wire (VCC) to a stud on the positive busbar.
 - o Attach the ground wire (GND) to a stud on the negative busbar.
 - o Use bolts, washers, and lock washers to secure the lugs tightly, following the torque specifications if provided .
5. **Add Fusing** Install a fuse between the busbar and the USB power source to protect against overcurrent. For multiple USB ports, consider individual fuses for each line or a single fuse rated for the total current . 6. **Insulate and Protect** Cover exposed busbar terminals with heat shrink tubing, insulating sleeves, or protective covers to prevent accidental contact and short circuits. Ensure wires are neatly routed and secured to avoid strain on the connections . 7. **Test the Connection** After wiring, use a multimeter to check continuity and verify correct voltage at the USB connector. Confirm that all connections are secure and that there is no risk of shorting . 8. **Mounting and Final Setup** Position the busbar in a safe, accessible location. Ensure the USB connector is mounted securely and that wires have a gentle bend radius to prevent stress or damage over time . By following these steps, you can safely wire a USB connector to a busbar, providing a clean, organized, and reliable power distribution point for multiple USB devices.
