Materials and Protective Layers

- o Protective layers: LSZH (low-smoke zero-halogen) or PE sheaths provide flame retardancy, UV resistance, and environmental protection .
- o Optional steel or FRP members: For tensile strength and compression resistance, especially in pipeline or

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outdoor applications .
