Cable tray tees are branch fittings that connect three tray sections, available in equal, unequal, horizontal, and vertical configurations to support efficient cable routing.

Overview of Cable Tray Tee Fittings

A cable tray tee fitting is designed to create a branch connection from a main cable tray route into one or more secondary routes while maintaining continuous cable support and structural integrity . Unlike bends, which change direction, tees allow cables to split efficiently, reducing the need for onsite modifications and improving installation quality .

Types of Cable Tray Tees

1. Equal Tees

- o All three tray sections have the same width.
 - o Commonly used when the branch route requires the same capacity as the main tray.
 - o Simplifies installation and ensures uniform cable support .
- ### 2. Unequal Tees
- o The branch section has a different width than the main tray.
 - o Ideal for situations where the branch carries fewer cables or a smaller load.
 - o Provides flexibility for future expansion or varying cable volumes .
- ### 3. Horizontal Tees
- o All tray sections remain on the same elevation.
 - o Suitable for standard branching in equipment rooms, data centers, or commercial electrical systems .
- ### 4. Vertical Tees

Vertical Tees

- o The branch rises above or below the main tray route.
- o Useful for connecting trays across different floor levels or routing over obstacles .

Material and Finish Options

- o Mild steel: Pre-galvanized (PG) or hot-dip galvanized (HDG)
- o Stainless steel: Grade 1.4404 (316L) for corrosion resistance
- o Aluminum or FRP: Lightweight and non-corrosive options for specialized environments
