For a few types of installations, the National Electrical Code (NEC) specifies the cable tray type to be used: Single conductor cables and Type MV cables must be installed in ladder or ventilated trough cable trays. A Vertical Cable Tray is a specialized support system designed to carry electrical and data cables securely in a vertical or riser direction. Think of it as the "spinal cord" or the "elevator shaft" for your cabling infrastructure, providing a protected and structured pathway for cables to travel. A cable tray system is a unit assembly of sections and fittings that forms a rigid structural system used to securely fasten or support cables and wiring. It maintains spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is bent the minimum bend radius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray is used for instrumentation and control applications that require. From a scientific and mechanical perspective, cable tray types differ in three key areas: A ladder cable tray consists of two longitudinal side rails connected by transverse rungs, forming a structure similar to a ladder. The rungs are typically spaced at 6 in, 9 in, or 12 in intervals.
