Essentially creating a room within the aisle, the system helps keep hot and cold air separated to make existing air conditioning systems in data center and edge-of-network. Refrigeration provided by CRAC (Computer Room Air Conditioning) unit to the aisle; Servers expel hot air into the room; Room-dependent solution.
