**Circuit Breakers:** These are the primary protective devices that automatically cut off power to a circuit in case of overload or short circuit, preventing damage to wiring and connected devices . **Residual Current Circuit Breaker (RCCB):** RCCBs detect small imbalances in current between live and neutral wires, protecting against electric shocks and enhancing safety . **Bus Bars:** Metal strips that conduct electricity within the box, serving as central connection points for multiple circuits. They distribute power efficiently to all outgoing circuits . **Isolators:** Manually operated switches that allow electricians to safely disconnect specific circuits for maintenance, reducing the risk of electric shock . **Neutral Link:** Provides a return path for electrical current, ensuring proper circuit operation and stability . **Grounding Bus Bar:** Directs excess current safely into the ground during faults, preventing electric shocks and fire hazards . **Surge Protective Device (SPD):** Protects the system from sudden voltage spikes caused by lightning or phase faults, safeguarding sensitive equipment . **Indication Lights:** Visual indicators that show the status and availability of the main power supply, allowing quick monitoring of the system . **Enclosure:** The outer case, typically made of durable thermoplastics or coated metal, protects all internal components from dust, moisture, and physical damage . **Electrical Wiring:** Connects all components and circuits, often including Miniature Circuit Breakers (MCBs) for individual devices or sub-circuits .
