Optional and Advanced Components

Timers and Doorbells: Integrated for specific control or signaling functions . **Energy Monitoring Units and Communication Modules:** Found in smart distribution boxes, enabling real-time data collection and remote control . **Fuses:** Sometimes used alongside breakers for additional protection in certain designs .
