

What are the optical ports on a 10 Gigabit switch

SFP+ optical ports convert electrical signals to optical signals and vice versa, enabling high-speed data transmission over fiber . Key benefits include:

- o High bandwidth: Supports 10 Gbps throughput, ideal for data centers and enterprise networks .
