While the primary function of a distribution box is to manage and protect circuits using devices like MCBs, RCCBs, or RCBOs, some setups may include meter panels or integrated meters to monitor energy usage for specific sub-circuits or areas . This is particularly common in commercial or industrial installations where energy tracking for different departments or equipment is required.
