

What fiber optic cable does a gigabit router need

- o LAN ports: Gigabit or multi-gigabit ports are recommended for wired devices to avoid bottlenecks .
- o Wi-Fi standard: Wi-Fi 6, 6E, or emerging Wi-Fi 7 provides higher throughput and better performance for multiple devices .
- o Processor and RAM: Sufficient internal processing power is necessary to manage high-speed traffic efficiently .

Ethernet Cabling

To connect your router to the ONT and devices, Cat 5e, Cat 6, or Cat 6a Ethernet cables are typically used. Cat 6a is ideal for future-proofing and maintaining maximum gigabit performance over longer distances . Fiber optic cables are only required up to the ONT; inside your home, standard Ethernet cables are sufficient.
