- o Sections must be lifted carefully by the main body, not by the ends, to avoid bending or conductor damage .

- o Inspect each section for damage before installation; any defects should be reported to the supplier .
- o Ensure all connections are tight and properly torqued to maintain electrical continuity and prevent overheating .
- o Personal protective equipment (PPE) should be worn at all times during installation .
