Unlike fiber connectors, which can be plugged and unplugged, splicing creates a fixed connection that is typically more stable and has lower insertion. Because optical fibers are sensitive to pulling, bending, and crushing forces, use fiber splice trays to provide secure routing and an easy-to-manage environment for fragile fiber splices. In the past, fiber optic splice trays were usually installed in a box that hung on the wall. Splice trays help maintain: They do not modify signal. A splice closure is a protective enclosure used to house and protect optical fiber splices from environmental damage, such as moisture, dust, temperature fluctuations, and mechanical stress.
