

What is used for sealing cable trays

Cable trays can be effectively sealed using weatherstops, GRP sealants, cable entry seals, and specialized plates or frames to prevent moisture, dust, and rodent ingress.

Weatherproofing for Wall and Roof Penetrations

For vertical wall penetrations, cable trays are often sealed using weatherstop systems, which may appear as ductwork or boxes attached to the building exterior. These systems create a sealed entrance for cables and can include GRP (glass-reinforced plastic) weathering systems, which are fiber-reinforced, cold-applied liquids that adapt to any cladding or roof type, providing a watertight and windproof seal while maintaining aesthetics. For roof penetrations, service risers and upstands are commonly used to ensure structural integrity and weatherproofing. GRP sealants or other waterproofing compounds can be applied around the tray to prevent water ingress and maintain a secure seal.

Cable Entry Seals

Cable entry seals are specialized fittings that create a watertight and dustproof barrier where cables pass through walls, panels, or enclosures. Common types include:

- o Single-entry seals for individual cables.
- o Multi-entry seals for multiple cables through a single opening.
- o Right-angle seals for tight spaces where cables exit at 90° angles. These seals also provide strain relief and help maintain compliance with standards like IP67/IP68 or NEMA 4X, extending the life of electrical systems.

Plates, Glands, and Frames

Sealing can also be achieved using cable entry plates, grommets, glands, or frames. Plates can be round, rectangular, or square, accommodating multiple cables and reducing the number of cutouts needed. Modern cable entry plates may have anywhere from 4 to 72 entries, allowing for flexible installation. WSP weatherstop systems use a powder-coated or galvanized steel frame with water-resistant pads and silicone-based sealant to provide a weathertight seal. These units can be installed before or after the tray and accept any cable size or quantity, making maintenance and cable changes straightforward.

Sealants and Compounds

Additional sealing can be done with duct seal putty, silicone-based sealants, or GRP compounds, which block moisture, airflow, and dust while protecting cables from environmental hazards and corrosive gases.
