Safe Installation Recommendations

- o Always use terminal blocks or busbars inside the box for connections .
- o Ensure adequate space for heat dissipation and avoid overcrowding wires .
- o Maintain neat cable management and secure grounding to prevent accidental contact .
- o Perform insulation and continuity tests before powering the system .
- o If additional connections are needed, consider using a larger box or junction box rather than connecting wires underneath the existing distribution box .
