Fiber cable splicing is the process of permanently joining two optical fibers end-to-end to allow light signals to pass through with minimal loss. All the fiber be protected by the bare fiber protection tube, then routing to the fiber optic distribution and splicing modular. Splices are generally placed in a splice tray which is then placed inside a splice closure or integrated into a fiber pedestal for OSP installations. For premises applications (indoors) splice trays are often integrated into patch panels or wall-mounted boxes to provide for connections for the. Modern splice trays have molded plastic loop guides -- circular or oval channels that fibers route around.
